No Model	No Model	Model	In 2016, the BHC established the Navigation Committee to develop a navigation model for the behavioral health treatment system. The Navigation Committee heard from several different navigation efforts including hospitals, DuPage County Community Services, and 1 in 4 Mental Health. Members also contacted agencies with navigation efforts in other parts of the country. A potential navigation model to serve uninsured/Medicaid populations and expand psychiatric capacity was in preliminary discussions in early 2017.
